

Missouri High School & JR High Rodeo Newsletter Fall, 2010

It's almost time for the fall rodeos to start, for our new year of the Missouri High school Rodeo. This packet contains several important documents, most of which require the attention of you and your parents. Please share this information with them as soon as you have looked through it. Please note deadlines, call-in times, and other important dates. Also, you should **KEEP this NEWSLETTER for future references**. PACKET CONTENTS

Please check your packets to ensure that you have copies of all the following documents. If you are missing any, please contact me, Terri Brookshier, State Secretary, or download them off the web site. You may also make additional copies of any of these documents as needed.

1. National High School application. This is a 2 page form (front and back), which is a REQUIRED form. Please fill out the form completely and **mail it back to me no later than September 15, 2010**, or bring to 1st rodeo. **Please note this form is required to be notarized-** you need to take care of this before you send it back, or bring it to the rodeo.
2. Copy of Birth Certificate
3. **High School only** Missouri High School Rodeo, Inc application form, also a 2 page form. This form requires notary signatures as well, please take care of before you mail it back. The back side of this form is your parent's application for Adult membership- you get 2 free adult memberships with your dues, please have them fill this out. This is a **REQUIRED** form.
4. Privacy Release policy. The law requires us to ask permissions to publish your name, address, and phone number in a membership directory. Please fill out the enclosed form and return it along with your other documents. We will not post this information on the web site.
5. Bio-Sheet. This full size sheet will be used by our rodeo announcers, sponsors, and state secretary. Please return this form with all your other documents. **Please do not fill out the sponsor section, I will do this when your sponsor money comes in.**

The meeting for all High School Students/Parents will be at 5:30pm Saturday, September 25th at the Unionville Rodeo. This is a mandatory meeting and official dress is required for the students.

Grade Cards

Any potential member must submit a copy of his/her final grades for the 2009-2010 school year. It should be an original copy of the transcript or grade report, which must be obtained from the school counselor or principal. **PACKETS WILL NOT BE**

PROCESSED UNTIL GRADE CARDS ARE RECEIVED!

According to the NHSRA regulations, all home schoolers must submit documentations of current Missouri State Department of Education approval of your home school program. This must be submitted at the time of your new rodeo application, even if you have competed in a prior year.

To be eligible to compete in Missouri High School Rodeo, you must have passed at least four subject areas on your most recent report card. Your grade card will be kept on file with your other paper work.

Dress Code and Back Number

As stated in rule #11 in our MHSR Ground rules, Dress Code: Contestants, whether competing or not, will wear western attire (as stated in the rule book) in the spectator area until any High School or Jr High Division performance, including Cutting and the queen contest, has ended. In addition, official dress is required at mandatory meetings within the arena area. Also parent volunteers, who help out in the arena area are expected to wear official dress. Official dress consists of: cowboy hat, boots, long-sleeve **collared** shirt, and jeans. Once students have been assigned back numbers, the numbers become part of your official dress as well. Back numbers are to be worn by students throughout the weekend, even when not in official dress, other than when you are swimming, bathing, or sleeping. **Failure to follow dress code can result in disqualification.**

Sponsor Money

MHSR contestants are asked to raise \$300 in sponsorship, This can be accomplished in a number of ways: Sell \$300 worth of calendars, obtain individual sponsorship from family, businesses or organizations. \$150 due at fall 1st rodeo and \$150 due at spring 1st rodeo, if this is not paid you will not be able to compete.

JR High contestants are asked to raise \$100 in sponsorship.

Fall Schedule 2010

The board has approved 5weekends (10 rodeos)each for the fall & spring season. The Jr High board approved 3 rodeos for the fall and spring, with 100%of the points counting High Schoolmay drop two rodeos for the year. At this time only 4 have been scheduled. To enter you must call in the Monday prior to the weekend rodeo, email barb by Monday at 12pm prior to that weekend, or after the first rodeo there will be books available to sign up for the remaining rodeos. Be prepared to pay your fees by check or cash.

Fees: Fees are \$55 per event for two days, with an option to enter for one day at \$42.

Payback: Payback is based on the number of entries in the event

1entry-1 money-100%

2-4 entries-2 monies-60%, 40%

5-8 entries-3 monies-50%, 30%, 20%

9-12entries-4 monies- 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%

13-29 entries-5 monies-30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%

30 or more entries-6 monies-29%, 24%, 19%, 14%, 9%, 5%

The maximum number of points which could be earned per event at a sanctioned qualifying rodeo (excluding state finals) would be 10 points and points for 10 places.

Points per event: 1st=10, 2nd=9, 3rd=8, 4th=7, 5th=6, 6th=5, 7th=4, 8th=3, 9th=2, 10th=1.
